Monterey Bay Aquarium Coastal Wetlands "I Spy" Activity

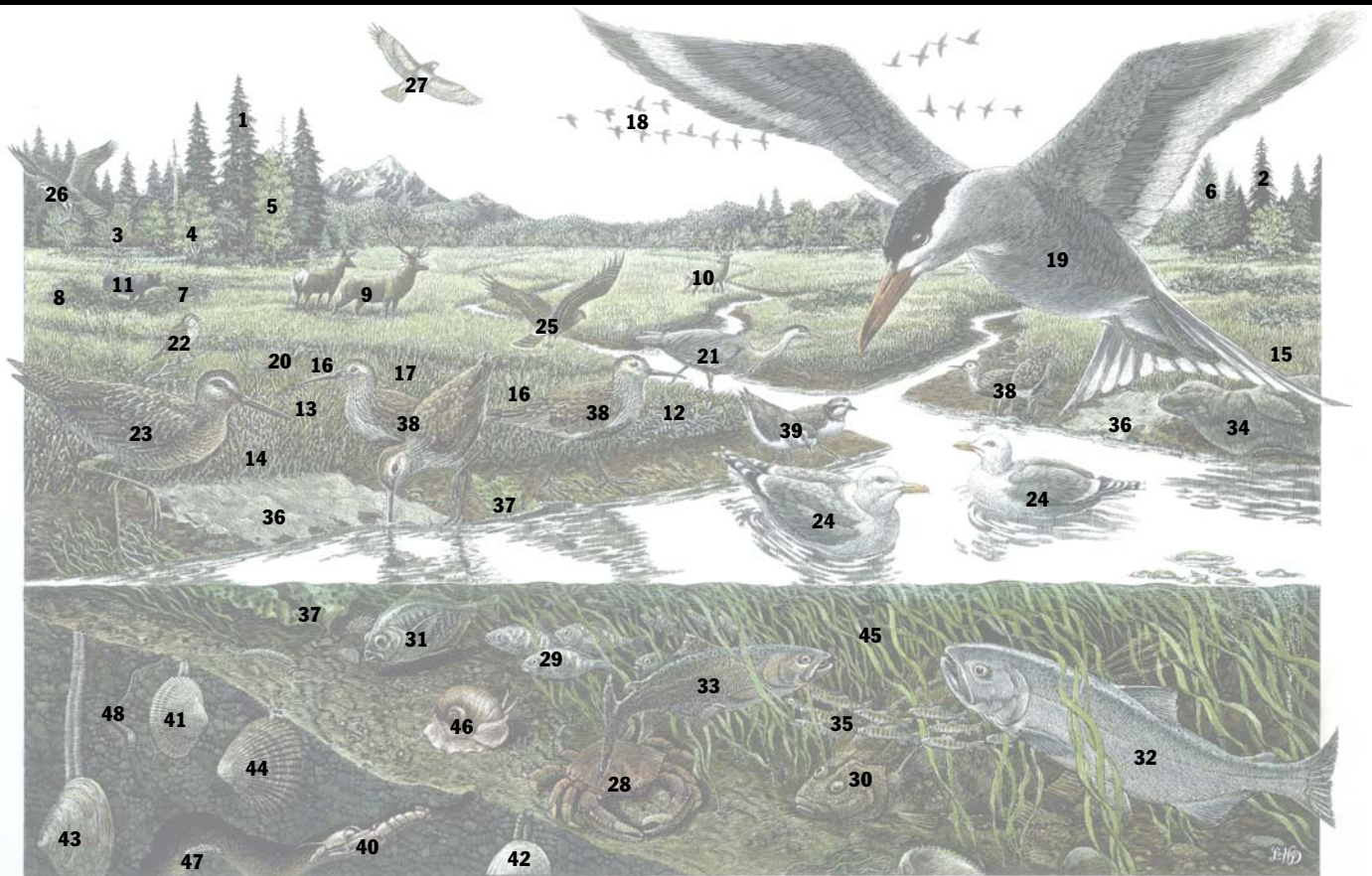
